Compliance Officers Body Worn Camera Trial

Passenger Transport Compliance Officers are currently trialling the use of body worn cameras.

These cameras will be used by compliance officers in their daily activities while monitoring compliance and standards in line with Passenger Transport legislative requirements.

As shown in the photograph, the cameras are highly visible and clearly labelled. Compliance Officers will advise the person in their initial greeting that they are wearing a camera and that the vision and audio is being recorded. A light on the camera will illuminate when recording.

Recorded data is uploaded to a secure site for viewing at a later time.

It is expected that the body worn cameras will contribute to a safer environment, generate efficiencies in the collection, storage and retention of evidence and potentially lead to early resolution of issues.

Please note, there are strict governance measures in place surrounding every aspect of the process.
